

REMOVING SPACING BETWEEN PARAGRAPHS WITH THE SAME STYLE

If you want to manually add a line break within a style without creating extra space between the lines, **check whether additional spacing (before or after) has been applied to that style in addition to line spacing.**

In the example below, the heading style includes 18 points of space after the text. If you want to manually split the heading into lines by pressing the **Enter** key, select the checkbox **Don't add space between paragraphs of the same style.**

1. Select the text you want to modify (e.g., the heading).
2. Right-click to open the context menu as shown below.
3. Adjust the settings as needed and click **OK**.
